



2026 Grantmaking Priorities & Strategy

What is changing?

- **Community Grants:** Each year we will offer the opportunity to apply for funding up to \$15,000 to respond to urgent needs and opportunities.
- **Impact Grants:** Every other year, we will offer the opportunity to apply for operating grants between \$50,000 - \$75,000.
- Every other year, we will offer the opportunity to apply for capacity building support via individual grants and/or cohorts. More to come!

What is staying the same?

- We will direct the majority of our foundation-directed grantmaking towards organizations supporting basic needs of individuals living in poverty and the revitalization of communities with a high rate of poverty.
- We will offer grants for up to \$15,000 to support projects and/or emergency needs.
- We will continue to issue an annual RFP for the Greensburg Foundation Fund.
- ALL organizations are invited to participate in our WestCo Nonprofit Network opportunities and capacity-building projects.

What about donor advised funds?

Donor-advised funds will continue distributing grants in alignment with their fundholders' charitable priorities.

Why are we updating our strategy?

As a community foundation, we periodically adapt our grantmaking to meet the evolving needs of our community. We continue to support vulnerable populations, but how we do so may change over time.
