- Established by more than 25 individuals and families
- Support organizations that serve the needs of Greensburg
- \$150,000 to grant in 2022

Guidelines

•Grant Amount

- \$20,000 maximum

•Eligibility

- Organizations serving residents of 15601 zip code

•Restrictions:

- Operating costs will not be funded
- Organizations can only submit one application

Examples of Requests

- Technology needs
- Personal care items for shelters or housing programs
- Food purchases for feeding programs
- Educational supplies for after school program
- Office renovations
- Capital projects such as new construction
- Programmatic costs

- **Applications Due** on July 15th (by 11:59pm)
- **Panel** of Greensburg leaders and CFWC board and staff
- **Grants Announced** on August 31st

If Funded

- Funds distributed upon receipt of signed grant agreement
- Funds must be expended and projects completed by June 30, 2023
- Evaluation reports due by July 5, 2023
