### **Revitalizing Westmoreland**

- Encourage new, creative ways to revitalize vulnerable communities
- Improve the quality of life for residents through funding that promotes Westmoreland County as a clean, safe, and productive place to live.
- Stimulate partnerships between neighborhood residents, business associations, civic groups, nonprofits, and local government.

### **Revitalizing Westmoreland**

To support programs and projects that

- Improve the physical assets in a community.
- Create partnerships between municipalities, nonprofits and residents to address the physical space in a community.
- Encourage transformational change (i.e.: lead to additional development).
- Connect projects to formal and informal community plans.

## **Eligible Programs & Projects**

#### **Examples:**

- Main Street Initiatives
- Façade Improvement Programs
- Streetscape or Planter Programs
- Beautification Programs
- Public Art
- Green Space Developments
- Playgrounds
- ADA Compliance Projects

# **Eligible Applicants**

- 501(c)3 Nonprofit Organizations
- Cities, Townships, Boroughs, or Municipalities
- Community Development Corporations
- Faith Based Organizations
- Civic or Community Groups
- Neighborhood Organizations

#### **Grant Size**

- Up to \$30,000
- CFWC should not be the sole funder of the requests.
- In kind contributions can be counted as additional revenues.

# **Ineligible Uses of Funds**

- Capital campaigns
- Fundraising events
- Lobbying
- Technology

#### Pitfalls to Avoid

- Project does not align with the guidelines
- Budget does not match request amount
- Budget does not include enough revenue
- Application does not include support letters from identified partners

### **Key Information to Include**

- Articulate the potential impact
- Identify and maximize partnerships
- Support letters for any named partners
- Explain track record of success working with identified population
- Realistic budget and timeline
- What sets your organization and project apart!

#### **Selection Criteria**

- The request demonstrates need.
- The application articulates the potential impact of the proposed project.
- The applicant has demonstrated their ability to implement the project
- The project leverages other investments (including in-kind and volunteer support).
- The budget and timeline are realistic.

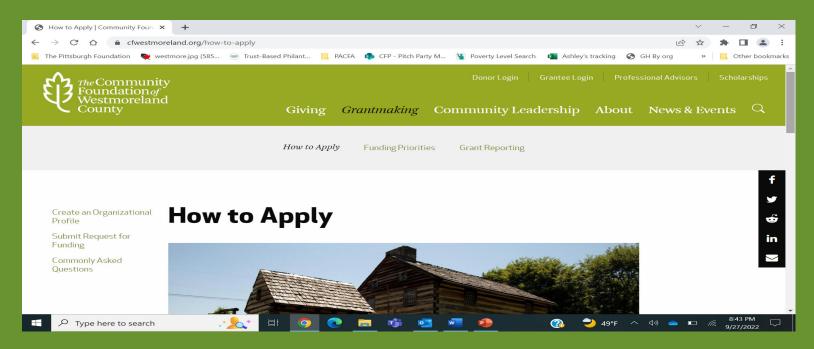

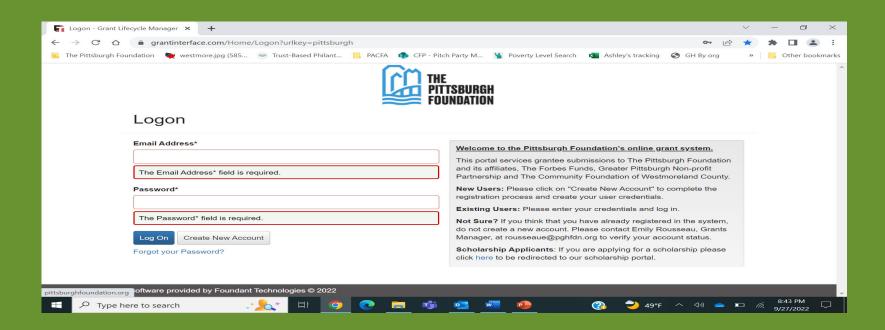
